They were recognized for their contributions to the research of right-brain education and development of Hado reading and the further expansion of these topics outside of Japan.

The ICPC was established in 1971 with Naruhiko Higashikuni, former Japanese imperial prince and the 43rd Prime Minister of Japan, serving as its first president. Hiroaki Fushimi, a member of the former Japanese imperial family, is the fifth and current president of the ICPC. Many groups fall under the ICPC, including International Academy of Education. International Academy of Education is an academic society organized by scholars from medieval Cambridge and is the oldest and most authoritative group in Europe. Currently, participants include scholars, clergymen, and intellectuals from 107 countries. Other participating organizations are, U.S.A Nonprofit International Academy of Education, U.S.A Nonprofit Lincoln Memorial Foundation for Peace, The Pontiff of World Religion, The Japan-India Cultural Foundation, New Japan Fine Arts Association.
